

Two men who sexually assaulted a girl staying in a children's home were sentenced to ten years in prison

Trincomalee High Court Judge Manikavasakar Ilanchezhiyan sentenced two men to ten years in prison for raping a learning difficulty woman staying in a children's home.

The Attorney General had filed a case in the Trincomalee High Court against the 58-year-old Kanakarathnam Mariayadas and the 61-year-old Sivalingam George who had sexually assaulted a learning difficulty girl staying in a children's home in the Nilaveli area of Trincomalee in 2010.

The verdict of both of them was announced in the open court while the investigations regarding this case were concluded and a date was set for the judgment of the case.

According to this, the judge sentenced both of them to 10 years rigorous imprisonment and a fine of 5000 rupees, 1 month rigorous imprisonment for failure to pay the fine and compensation of 5 lakh rupees to the victim and 2 years rigorous imprisonment for failure to pay it.

Judge Ilanchezhiyan has sentenced two people who abused a learning difficulty girl in Trincomalee to 10 years of rigorous imprisonment.

A learning difficulty girl between the ages of 16 and 18 who was growing up in a children's home from Nilaveli Ilupai Kulam area, Trincomalee, was arrested on the grounds that she was sexually abused by her father and two children's home guards. The girl's father died while the case was pending in the Magistrate's Court. Separate cases were filed against both the guardians of the children's home in Trincomalee High Court. At the end of the trial, Judge Ilanchezhiyan ruled that both the guardians of the children's home were guilty and sentenced them to 10 years rigorous imprisonment, compensation of 5 lakhs and a fine of 5000 rupees.

The girl had testified in the court that the said girl was placed in a children's home housing project in Ilupaikulla and was raped several times with pills and needles. The children's home cannot be allowed to become a place of revelry and the guardians of the children's home who

are supposed to protect the girl cannot be forgiven for committing such a criminal act. Judge Ilanchezhiyan said that the guardians of the children's home should also be a warning bell. One of the opponents is 70 years old and the other is 63 years old. He also rejected the application for mercy and sentenced them to 10 years' imprisonment with a severe warning.

Before going to the children's home, when the girl was raped by her father while at home, her mother committed suicide by pouring kerosene on herself and setting herself on fire. Then again the father and her guards abused her.
